## About the new Western Sydney Stadium

A new 30,000 seat rectangular stadium is proposed on the site of the existing Pirtek Stadium at Parramatta.

The NSW Government is getting on with the job of delivering the Western Sydney Stadium as part of the \$1.6 billion stadia strategy to improve sporting infrastructure across the state.

The new Western Sydney Stadium will:

- » be able to cater for bigger crowds, provide an improved game day experience and bring major benefits to the Western Sydney economy
- » generate approximately 1,200 jobs during construction and between 600 and 900 jobs once operational for sporting event days and major events
- » cater for a range of sporting and community uses within the precinct.

The new Western Sydney Stadium is being delivered by Projects NSW in partnership with Venues NSW.

The new Western Sydney Stadium will be used for a range of sports including rugby league, football, rugby union and a range of other events such as concerts, markets and fairs.

The new Western Sydney Stadium will have:

- » comfortable seating for 30,000 people
- » high-quality food and beverage facilities
- » five levels of premium, corporate and function spaces
- » big screens
- » advanced technology including wifi and broadcast facilities
- » improved security and administration
- improved pedestrian and public plazas areas and landscaping around the stadium.
