

New Western Sydney Stadium Planning Process and Concept Plan

The project will be assessed as a State Significant Development. Planning approval will be obtained in two stages:

Stage 1: stadium concept proposal and demolition approval

Stage 2: stadium design, construction and operation.

The new Western Sydney Stadium is scheduled to open in 2019.

Environmental Impact Statement

An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for Stage 1 approval is on public exhibition from 21 July to 19 August 2016. The EIS assesses potential environmental issues related to the concept proposal and demolition. We invite you to view the EIS and make a submission at www.majorprojects.planning.nsw.gov.au.

Submissions must be received in writing by 19 August to be considered during the Stage 1 planning approval process. All submissions may be made public.

Stadium concept proposal

The concept proposal provides urban design guidelines for the stadium design during Stage 2. The concept proposal considers how the new stadium, playing field and associated public plazas, landscaping and access will come together. This will create a distinctive identity for the precinct, while remaining sensitive to the existing parkland and riverine setting.
