Pedestrian impacts to Glebe Foreshore Walk

Dear Neighbour

The NSW Government is delivering a new Sydney Fish Market which will retain its authentic experience and strengthen its position as one of Australia's leading tourist destinations.

Upcoming works – Installation of western promenade piles adjacent to Glebe Foreshore Walk

On **Monday 11 April and Tuesday 12 April**, piles will be installed within the site boundary adjacent to the Glebe Foreshore Walk. A crane barge and excavator will be used to carry out the works.

Works will be completed in line with project respite hours, with **brief intermittent restrictions to pedestrian access** occurring between 9am-midday and 1-5pm.

How this affects you

- Temporary barriers will be in place on the Glebe foreshore walk to maintain a five-metre exclusion zone when hammering works are in operation. Please note pedestrian access will not be impacted as a two-metre walkway will be maintained.
- Additionally, spotters will be present for the full duration of works.
- This work has been scheduled during school holidays to minimise disruption to the adjacent Sydney Secondary College.

We understand the potential impacts this may cause to the local community. Thank you for your understanding during this work.
