


# Power Upgrade Works

## How will local impacts be managed?

To manage the impact these night works may have on local residents and road users, the route has been split into four zones (see map).

This zoning will allow targeted scheduling, to ensure work will take place in each zone on no more than two nights per week, providing respite and mitigating local impacts.

## Other mitigation measures include:

- No more than two nights of work per week in each zone.
- Traffic control will be in place at all times to guide vehicles and cyclists around the works zone.
- Safe alternative routes and crossings for pedestrians will be provided.
- Driveway access for residents will be maintained.
- Noisy works such as trenching will be undertaken early in the shifts to minimise impacts.
- Regular traffic conditions and pedestrian access will be restored at the end of each shift.

## Why are the power upgrade works needed?

As part of the new Sydney Fish Market project, a significant program of works will be undertaken to deliver 11kv high voltage power to the new facility.

This work will involve trenching and installing conduit and cabling between the zone substation at Lyons Rd, Camperdown and the project site in Glebe. The 1.8km route, mainly via Bridge Road, Glebe is detailed in the map above.

## What is the timeframe?

These upgrade works are due to commence on 20 June 2022 and will take approximately six months.

## Works will occur mainly at night between 6pm and 5am, Sunday to Friday.

Scheduling this work at night is necessary to maintain community safety and ensure minimal disruption to traffic.

Please note the works schedule will be released prior to the start of works and be subject to weather and conditions.

## Will there be local impacts?

There will be some impacts to traffic and pedestrian movements along Bridge Road and Lyons Road. Some kerbside parking spaces may be unavailable for short periods during the work. Some of these works may be noisy at times.

We understand the potential disruption this work may cause to local residents and thank you for your understanding. Safety of the public will be the highest priority of all times.
