

# Power Upgrade Works

New Sydney Fish Market



## What is the 11kV power upgrade?

Multiplex is currently undertaking works to deliver an upgraded high voltage power supply to the new Sydney Fish Market from an existing zone substation in Camperdown.

This work involves trenching and installing conduit and cabling along a 1.8km route from Lyons Road, Camperdown to the new Sydney Fish Market site via Bridge Road, Glebe. The route is shown in the map above.

## What is the timeframe?

These works commenced in mid-2022 and will take several months.

Works are occurring mainly at night between **6pm and 5am, Sunday to Friday**.

Scheduling this work at night is necessary to maintain community safety and ensure minimal disruption to traffic flow.

Please note the schedule may change due to weather, site conditions and authority approvals.

## What are the local impacts?

There are some impacts to traffic, cyclists and pedestrian movements during this work. Some kerbside parking spaces may be temporarily unavailable. The work will be noisy at times.

Four approved temporary compounds will be established for the storage of machinery and equipment. These are located in Lyons Road, Railway Street, Talfourd Street and Woolley Street.

## Why is the route zoned?

The route has been divided into zones (see map) to provide respite for residents. Work will be limited to two nights per week in each zone.

## What other mitigation measures will be in place?

- Noisier works will be undertaken prior to 12am.
- Traffic controllers will guide vehicles and cyclists around the works zone.

- Safe alternative routes and crossings for pedestrians will be provided.
- Bus routes will be maintained with minor relocation of bus stops when necessary.
- Driveway access will be maintained.
- Regular traffic conditions and pedestrian access will be restored at the end of each shift.

We understand the disruption this work may cause and appreciate your patience and understanding.
